#### Create PDF files with a click

Acrobat makes it easy to convert documents created in any application to PDF, including Web pages and scanned paper documents. You can even create PDF forms that users can fill in and return online. Automatically optimize the PDF files you create for your document's destination: the screen, your laser printer, or a printing press. PDF faithfully captures and preserves every font, image, and color of your original. Best of all, anyone with the free Acrobat Reader (available at www.adobe.com) can view and print PDF files from any computer.

#### Enhance and annotate electronically

Acrobat efficiently streamlines document reviews. Make PDF files easy to navigate with useful bookmarks and Web links. Then, e-mail them to colleagues or clients, who can electronically mark up PDF documents directly with electronic sticky notes, highlights, underlines, strikethroughs, and other powerful editing tools. Security features let you control access to confidential information.

#### Reliably distribute to anyone anywhere

Deliver compact PDF documents on your network server, posted on your Web site or intranet, attached to e-mail, or in a Lotus Notes database. Rest assured that no matter what applications or fonts they have installed, recipients will experience information just as you intend. 

#### Quickly create PDF files

- Convert any document to PDF, which faithfully captures and preserves the original document's fonts, colors, images, and layout.
- Simply drag and drop a document onto the Acrobat application window to automatically convert it to PDF.\*
- Take advantage of the "Create Adobe PDF" File menu and toolbar options that Acrobat automatically installs in Microsoft\* Word, Excel, and PowerPoint\* applications.
- Select one of three options to automatically optimize your document for your output medium: your local network printer for everyday paper copies and proofs, a professional printing press for more sophisticated publications, or the Web for online documents.
- With the Paper Capture tool, instantly convert scanned paper documents to PDF.
- Combine PDF pages from multiple sources into a single new PDF document.
- Create thumbnails of PDF pages and move, copy, reorder, or delete pages at a glance.
- Create PDF forms that look exactly like your paper versions, complete with pop-up boxes, buttons, and text fields.
  Acrobat Reader users can fill them out and return them over the Web, and
  Acrobat 4.0 users can save forms to their hard drives to fill out and return at their convenience.
- With the Web Capture tool, create PDF "snapshots" of Web pages or sites in one easy step for convenient offline viewing and printing.\* Acrobat even automatically creates bookmarks from HTML tags.





Convert documents to PDF: it's fast and easy. Working in Microsoft Office? On a PC, just choose File > Create Adobe PDF or simply drag and drop your Office file onto the Acrobat application window for instant PDF conversion.

You can also convert visually rich files created in graphics applications such as Adobe Photoshop, Adobe PageMaker, and Adobe Illustrator. Acrobat ensures recipients can view and print PDF files exactly as they were created.

### Enhance with security and navigation features



- Use the Acrobat SelfSign digital signature tool to enable key reviewers to sign off on PDF files electronically.\* Acrobat also supports leading third-party signature solutions.
- Use the Acrobat Catalog tool to create full-text indexes on your network or CD-ROM that are searchable with Acrobat Search.
- With the Acrobat Search tool, find exactly the information you're looking for in indexes of PDF files.

 Make PDF files easy to explore by adding bookmarks, links to other PDF files or to the Web, and dynamic controls that trigger sounds, movies, and effects.

#### Review documents electronically

- Quickly mark up PDF files using the Highlight Text, Underline Text, and Strikethrough Text tools, and more.
- Add text annotations directly to PDF files or use electronic "sticky notes" with the Notes tool.
- Make handwritten marks with the mouse-controlled Pencil tool.
- Summarize annotations in their own PDF file for easy reference or sort annotations by author, type, date, or page number.
- Print PDF files complete with mark-ups and "sticky notes."
- Mark PDF documents with handy clipart stamps (like "Approved" and "Confidential").

Quickly distribute PDF files anywhere over the Web, via e-mail, over your network server, on CD-ROM, or by using all of the above. Rest assured that no matter what applications, fonts, or systems they have installed, recipients will experience your documents just as you created them.


